

THE ICELANDIC RESPONSE

46 NURSING HOMES
18 DAY-CARE CENTERS

- The Ministry of Health,
- The Directorate of Health,
- The Chief Epidemiologist,
- Doctors and nurses specializing in geriatrics;

formed a consultation group on nursing home issues and day care centers during the pandemic.

Issued National Guidelines categorized by 3 levels of urgency.

Including common restrictions procedures - visits and access to nursing home



The Directorate of Health, The Chief Epidemiologist & the Department of Civil Protection and Emergency Management launched the "SVÖT" [swat] team.

Team of 5 specialists — instant response via 112 (911)


First response – infection has or might have entered the premises

A JOINT COVID-19 ISOLATION WARD FOR NURSING HOME RESIDENTS

Association of Companies in Welfare services and the Icelandic Health insurance and Eir nursing home opened a joint isolation ward

Tomorrow we are opening an isolation ward for elderly C-19 patients that do not need specialized hospitalization but can not isolate at home.

 - Quarantine those that have been exposed
 - Empower all HCW
 - Tangible multi level support
 - Co-operation
